Court Assignments

- **All players must sign in** before playing. Thank you.
- Courts are assigned first-come, first-served after your full group arrives.
- Assignments are 1 hour for 2 or 3 players, 1 1/2 hours for doubles.
- Primetime: Sat/Sun/Hol 8AM-Noon. No lessons given, no free play, and no junior play if adult members are waiting during these periods.

Guests (“Free play” dates at right)

- **Members’ Guests: \$20/day**
 - **Drop-In Guests: \$25/day**
- No one may be a guest more than 5 days/season.

Certificate Refund Policy:

A certificate holder who wishes to resign from the Club must mail a letter of resignation before the Opening Party to be eligible for a refund that calendar year. A certificate holder who has resigned may not play as an annual member for two seasons. Money is refunded in late fall when the Club closes its books. Funds that remain after all outstanding obligations have been satisfied will be divided among those eligible for refunds.

- **Certificate holders who pay dues this season** get 5 day passes & their children ages 6-18 play free.
- **New members always** pay the “Early” price (if one is available).

Using the Dues Application Form

Please complete enclosed form(s) as follows:

- Each person completes his/her own form.
- Print your name (and contact info if new or changed).
- Check the correct boxes in the flowchart until you reach your correct dues amount.
- Only certificate holders who loaned the club \$1000 in 2000 may deduct \$100 from their dues. Alternatively these individuals may donate their loan refund to the club.
- New certificate holders should check whether they are buying a couple certificate or an individual certificate. Payments can be made over two or three years. Please inquire at 679-5900.

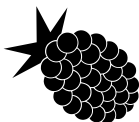
