## Dues

**Certificate Holders:** Dues for 2001 are the same as 2000. **Please send payment by April 15th** (*see page 3*), so the club has working funds for the season. The work option has been discontinued (*see page 2*).

**Last Year's Trial Members:** We want you back as a full member! "Capitalize" on your terrific 2000 experience. Get a Certificate; be an owner. **2001 First-time Members:** All are welcome, and we encourage you to become certificate holders. But to just try us out, here's the deal: Unlimited play for a single person for \$625, or for a couple, \$1100. Get 25 hours of play for \$350. Still a bargain for the best courts in the area. ## News and Policies

### Court Congestion

#### Changes for 2001

The courts can get crowded on fine weekend mornings. Two changes to this year's court rules affect Saturday and Sunday prime time play (8AM-Noon):

1. Guests will pay more if they play during prime time (\$15 versus \$10)
2. Junior members may not play during prime time if adult members are waiting



#### Other Fees for 2001

This year, WTC will charge:

#### Guests (per day):

\$15 Saturday or Sunday before noon  
\$10 Other times

Guests are limited to 5 visits/season

#### Lessons (per hour):

\$45 Members      \$55 Non-Members

#### Junior Camp (per week):

\$125 Members      \$140 Non-Members

### Certificate Refund Policy

It is the intent of the Woodstock Tennis Club, Inc. to refund Certificates in full under the following conditions, which may be amended:

- When a departing member requests a refund and no longer plays at the club, the member's name is placed on a waiting list for refunds, in request order.
- Then, when new Certificate Fees are received after the refund request, and the funds are not required for operation of the club, the refund is given.

All refunds requested to date have been given.

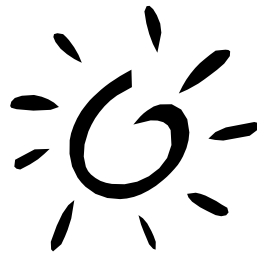
