- All pricing is per person (no couples rates)
- Take advantage of the payment discount—pay before 4/15/02
- Certificate holders pay the lowest rates, get 2 free guest passes, pay lower guest rates than other members, and get free play for children
- Certificate holders own the club, and may vote on policy
- There is a new 20-day plan, versus old 25-hour plan
- All past members are invited to return in 2002

Certificate Holders: You will receive a bill for your 2002 dues, and, if it applies, your next certificate installment.

Past Trial Members: We want you back as a full member! "Capitalize" on your terrific WTC experience. Get a Certificate; be an owner, get those owner perks. Certificate payment plans are available (*see page 3*). *You may re-join in 2002 without a certificate, at higher rates.* Early payment discounts apply.

2002 New Members: All are welcome, and we encourage you to become certificate holders. But to just try us out, here's the deal choose from: 20 days of play through the season, unlimited play, or unlimited Monday to Friday play (except holidays). Prices start as low as \$395. As a new member, you get pre-season rates no matter when you join. News and Policies

Court Assignments

- **Courts are assigned:** first-come, first-served after your group arrives
- **Duration:** 1 hour for singles, 1 1/2 hours for doubles - Keep playing if no one is waiting
- **Primetime:** Saturday, Sunday or Holidays 8AM-Noon - no lessons given, higher guest fees, no juniors may play if adult members are waiting



Other Fees for 2002

Guests (per day):

\$20 Primetime \$15 Other times
(Guests of Certificate Holders get \$5 off these rates)

Each Guest is limited to 5 visits/season

Lessons (per hour):

\$45 Members \$50 Non-Members
Group and semi-private lessons are available

Junior Camp (per week):

\$125 Members \$140 Non-Members

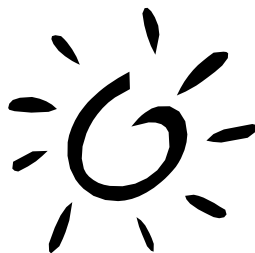
