Court Assignments

- **Before playing, all players *must* sign the sign-in sheet. Please cooperate.**
- Courts are assigned first-come, first-served after your group arrives
- Assignments are 1 hour for singles, 1 1/2 hours for doubles - you may stay on if no one is waiting
- Primetime is Saturday, Sunday or Holidays 8AM-Noon - no lessons given, higher guest fees, no juniors may play if adult members are waiting



Other Fees

Each Guest is limited to 5 visits/season

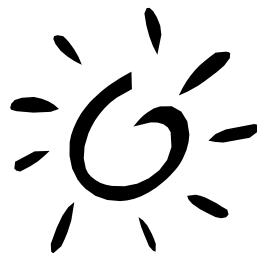
