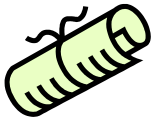

Woodstock Tennis will open again in late April. I am looking forward to it.

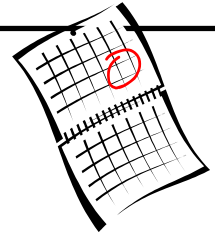

Court Assignments

- *All players must sign in before playing. Thank you.*
- Courts are assigned first-come, first-served after your full group arrives.
- Assignments are 1 hour for 2 or 3 players, 1 1/2 hours for doubles.
- Primetime: Sat/Sun/Hol 8AM-Noon. No lessons given, higher guest fees, and no junior play if adult members are waiting during these periods.
